Rector Writes

I think it is safe to say that 2 months ago, no-one thought that we would be watching news reports of people being arrested in a brawl over toilet paper in Australia. The corona virus induced panic buying of toilet paper (and tissues, and serviettes, and kitchen paper) this week has reminded us that the confidence of our world is paper thin (sorry for the pun). While it may look like our world is going well, all it takes is a few pictures on social media and a new virus and we are suddenly have so little confidence in our fellow humans that we think it a good idea to pile a shopping trolley high with toilet paper.
