"I have much to write to you, but I do not want to use paper and ink. Instead, I hope to visit you and talk with you face to face, so that our joy may be complete." (2 John 12) This little verse, from the end of one of the shortest books of the Bible, 2 John, has never seemed so precious to me. As John to his brothers and sisters in Christ, he was thankful that the technology of that time (paper and ink) enabled him to share his life with his readers. But he was also aware that his letters were no substitute for face to face contact. How good it will be to meet in the same physical room!

As we discover the joys of Youtube and Zoom (and give thanks to God for the skill of those who have made that technology possible), we are also aware, as John was, that we would rather meet face to face, so that our joy may be complete. There will be difficulties with the technology. The internet may be unreliable, or we might find ourselves frustrated with it. We will become more and more aware that screen time is not the same. Let us not give up meeting together online, and when the restrictions are lifted, let us not give up meeting together then either!
