Rector Writes

"For this reason I kneel before the Father, from whom every family in heaven and on earth derives its name".
(Ephesians 3:14-15)

As we reach another Father's Day, these verses from Ephesians remind us that before we had our earthly fathers, we had (and have) a heavenly father from before time.

Indeed, our very idea of fatherhood comes first of all from our heavenly father. This can be difficult for some, especially if their earthly father was not all that he should have been, or even worse, someone from whom they had to flee.

Even if we had difficult relationships with earthly fathers, we can draw comfort from our heavenly father, who loved us and gave his Son for us. For those who are mourning the loss of fathers today, we can likewise draw comfort from our heavenly father.

We can remember that God our Father created us, sustains us, redeemed us and will raise us to be with him. We can give thanks to our heavenly father for all his blessings, and call on him for strength when we are weak. What a privilege it is to call out 'Abba, Father' in prayer and to have him answer!
